

**MONTGOMERY COUNTY YOUTH AID PANEL PROGRAM  
COMMUNITY WORK SERVICE – JOB SITE CONTRACT**

The Community Work Service Program holds juveniles accountable for the delinquent acts they have committed. Under the guidance of the Youth Aid Panel members, juveniles volunteer to perform jobs in the community to repay the community for the harm they have caused. All juveniles participating in the program must complete the number of hours specified by the Youth Aid Panel.

The Youth Aid Panel agrees to:

- Screen all applicants, (however work site supervisor has the right to reject any applicant),
- Provide prompt support for any situation involving a juvenile which may be problematic, and
- Periodically contact site supervisors in person or by telephone.

The Montgomery County Juvenile Probation Department will:

- Provide accident and liability insurance through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Your Agency agrees to:

- Provide supervision during the juvenile's period of service, keep accurate record of time and return time sheet/evaluation to Youth Aid Panel,
- Report any problem,
- Follow the guidelines of the Child Labor Law, and maintain confidentiality regarding the juvenile's offense, background, etc.
